## Technology Requirements

### Computer Capabilities:

- Modem: Minimum 56 kbps speed is slow but adequate. A speed of 100 kbps (300 recommended) is needed for podcasts and 300 kbps (500 recommended) for videos

- A laptop on a wireless network will work, but will get better performance if plugged into a wired network

## *Course Description*

What's our main job in life? Some say simply that it is to glorify and enjoy God forever. One way we do this is through corporate worship. But what really makes for vital and faithful worship? How do spiritual leaders best guide it?

## *Course Goals*

- Participants in this course will explore the theology and structure of worship as expressed in the free church tradition.
- We will identify “ground rules” for making corporate worship meaningful, explore a variety of worship styles, emphasize inclusion of all ages in worship, experiment with ways to use music and visual arts and write prayers and other spoken resources.
- We will encourage each other's expressive gifts and develop them for planning and leading the gathered community in worship.

Lani Wright helped staff the production of *Hymnal: A Worship Book* (Church of the Brethren and Mennonite) and the *Hymnal Supplement* series. She also edited *Hymnal Companion* and *Brethren We Have Met to Worship*, worship planning software. She appreciates how ritual composes humans for their life struggles, and how humans compose ritual and music to express their faith.

Lani's “day job” is facilitating wellness, ecopsychology groups for people with mental illness and substance use disorders at Oregon State Hospital, a prison mental hospital.

She is ordained in the Church of the Brethren, holds degrees from Bridgewater College and Bethany Theological Seminary, is active on the Ministry Commission for Pacific Northwest District, and co-chairs the Camp Myrtlewood Board. She has written and edited numerous Bible study projects for junior and senior youth and adults.
